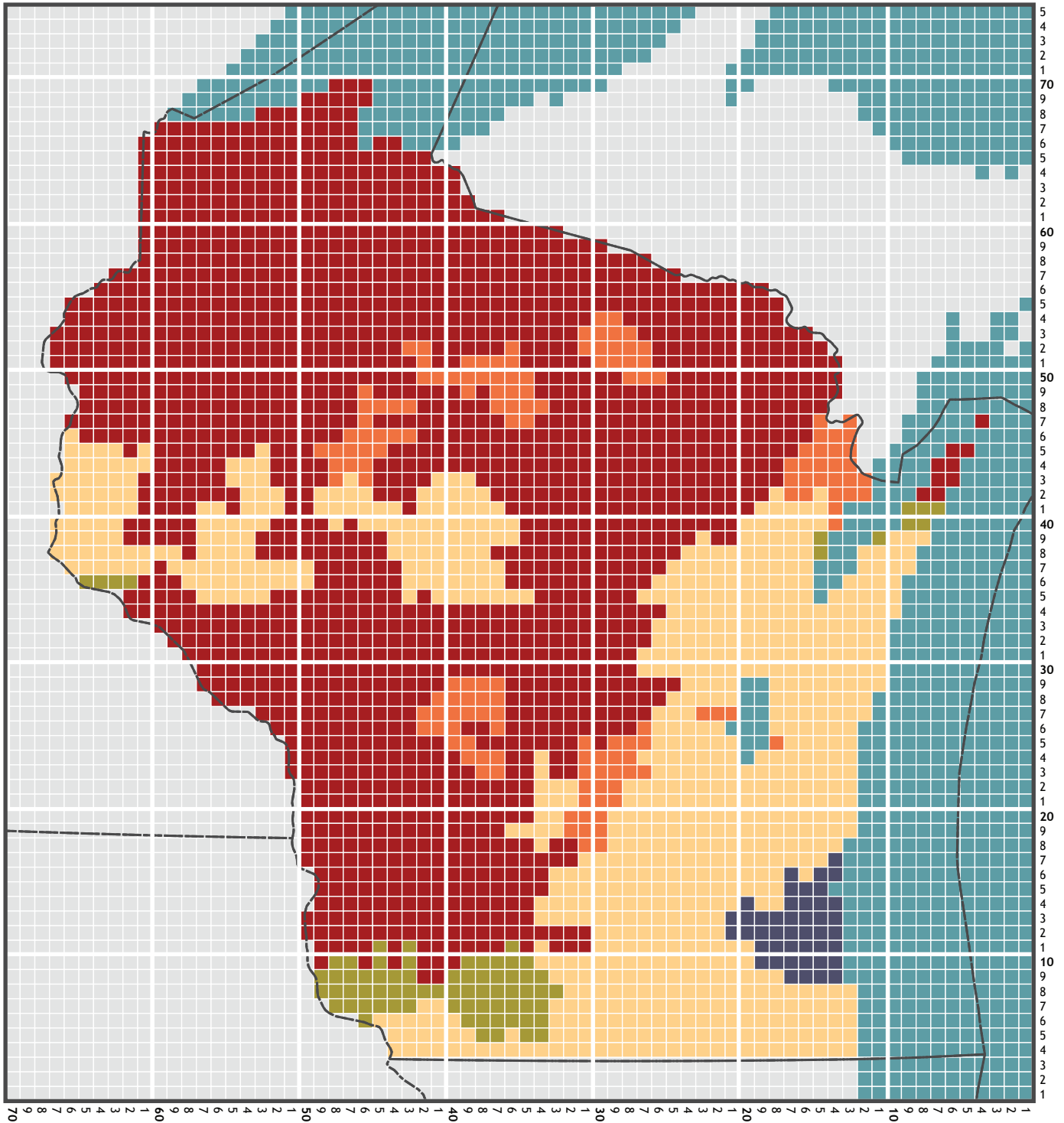


What does Wisconsin feel like?

A crochet landcover map of the badger state: pattern and legend



Wetlands & Minor Lakes
Teal blue single crochet
alternating back loop only

Forest
Sage green honeycomb bauble
stitch, layered

Urban area
Grey single crochet through
both loops

Grassland
Sage green or jute tuft stitch
with tassels in base layer

Agriculture
Jute or fall ombre ribbed stitch
through back loop only

Major lakes
Alternating blues in zigzag mosaic
or wave tufts

Other states
Ecru single crochet through both
loops

State borders
Grey chain stitching layered on top
of underlying stitches
